Work Hard

Heightened awareness of potential violence warning signs are shared responsibility of the command that require the intervention of the squadron Violence Prevention Officer (VPO), Chain of Command, or PMO.

Common indicators include:

- Social withdrawal
- Distorted perception of being singled out or picked on
- Change in personal appearance
- Holding grudges
